





Burton Schernikau, Artistic Director

Burton Schernikau is a graduate of Nebraska Wesleyan University and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln with a bachelor of music education and master of music degree with emphasis in music education, composition and arranging. After teaching for an extended number of years in Lincoln Public Schools, he is presently an adjunct professor in music education at Nebraska Wesleyan University. He has a private voice and piano studio and is an adjudicator and director for competitions, contests, workshops and other artistic events. He is the pianist for the Lincoln Midwest Ballet Company and a guest pianist for many professional ballet companies throughout the United States. He is the artistic director of the Lincoln Boys Choir Organization which has traveled world wide and been recognized for their unique style of choral singing. He has been recognized by the Nebraska Music Educators and received the Outstanding Music Alumni Award from Nebraska Wesleyan University. He has been chosen as an Admiral in the Navy in the Great State of Nebraska. He is a 33rd degree Mason and is the organist for the Scottish Rite and Shrine Organization.

Kevin Scheele, Associate Director

Kevin Scheele has been involved with the Lincoln Boys Choir since its revival in 2002, and has directed Concert Choir since 2004. He received his bachelor of music education degree from Nebraska Wesleyan University. While there, he studied voice with Boyd Bacon, vocal pedagogy and diction with Dr. Jana Holzmeier, and conducting with Dr. William Wyman. He also sang in the Nebraska Wesleyan University Choir, Chamber Choir, and Opera Workshop during his collegiate years, and continues to serve as a contracted singer and assistant conductor with the St. Paul UMC Chancel Choir. He taught vocal music at Lincoln Southeast High School for six years, having directed the freshman choir, junior varsity mixed choir, and sophomore swing choir. He spends time each summer attending choral workshops and serving on staff at the Nebraska Wesleyan Children's Choir Camp. He is a fifth generation Nebraska farmer, with his family's farming history dating back to 1885. His wife, Katie, is an art therapist and an adjunct professor of psychology at Nebraska Wesleyan University. Their daughters, Rachel and Chloe, are a source of joy for them both.



OUR HISTORY



The Lincoln Boys Choir originated in 1952, when the choir was sponsored by the Lincoln Public Schools. Until 1968, the choir, under the direction of Dr. Hugh Rangeler, provided hundreds of boys a myriad of educational opportunities through performances and travel. The group was then directed by Duane Nichols and Randy McEwen until it dissolved in 1972. In 2002, the Lincoln Scottish Rite Preservation Foundation provided the resources needed to reestablish the Lincoln Boys Choir. The organization is now comprised of three choirs of more than 100 boys, ages 8-18, and is an incorporated entity in its own right with a board of directors.

The choirs have performed with the University of Nebraska Men's Choir, Nebraska Wesleyan University Choir, and Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra. They have been featured on public television and during the National Orff and Kodaly Convention, the Nebraska Music Educators Association conference, the Nebraska Choral Directors Association conference, the Nebraska governor's inauguration and many other community events. The choirs have also received superior ratings and sweepstakes awards in competitions. Touring has included: Kansas City, New York City, Chicago, Austria, Czech Republic, and Italy, where they sang at the Vatican. The choir toured Ireland in June 2015.

In 2014, the Lincoln Boys Choir organization received the Richard Hay Arts Organization Award selected by the mayor of Lincoln and the Lincoln Arts Council. The award recognizes an arts group that has made significant contributions to Lincoln's arts community over a period of years.
