This document serves as your official invitation to return the Lincoln Boys Choir. Your choir placement for next year is _____.

EXPECTATIONS

We understand we must commit to the choir for the **ENTIRE** year. We understand my contribution to the group is important and I will demonstrate a positive work ethic at all times. We understand that I when I am absent, I or my parent should submit the reason for my absence to the directors via the online absence form at lincolnboyschoir.org.

We understand that we should be checking the choir calendar online for updates and changes to the schedule, adding choir events to our family's calendar. We understand that we are responsible for reading weekly email updates from the choir.

While participating in all performances are expected, we understand I am required to attend the holiday and spring performances, as well as special performances announced at the beginning of the year.

We understand that I am responsible for my actions when on tour or at concert sites. If my behavior is not up to the standards of the choir, my parents will be notified. In significant or repeat instances, I may lose my membership in the choir. We respect the property of St. Paul Church and will only be in the areas that have been opened to the choir. If I notice something wrong in the building, I will notify a staff member immediately.

We understand that we are expected to purchase the uniforms including white tuxedo shirt with a plain white undershirt, black tuxedo pants (and black jacket for Cantare), red or black bow tie, red or black cummerbund, black socks, black dress shoes, and a red or black LBC polo shirt. A red LBC sweatshirt is now optional, but recommended for cold weather casual performances. We understand that if formal or casual uniform items have been outgrown that we will replace them with new items before an event where uniforms are needed.

We understand that failure to comply with the guidelines set forth in this contract may result in suspension from major performances or possible dismissal from the choir, in significant or repeat instances.

We (parents/guardians) are aware that participation by choir members and their families will be expected in fundraising efforts and other support activities (concerts, committees, etc.), and we agree to fulfill our family obligation to the best of our ability.
